curl_easy_strerror - return string describing error code

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
const char *curl_easy_strerror(CURLcode errornum);
```

DESCRIPTION

The *curl_easy_strerror(3)* function returns a string describing the CURLcode error code passed in the argument *errornum*.

Typically applications also appreciate *CURLOPT_ERRORBUFFER(3)* for more specific error descriptions generated at run-time.

AVAILABILITY

This function was added in libcurl 7.12.0

RETURN VALUE

A pointer to a zero terminated string.
